

**NOTICE OF \$20,000 REWARD
OFFERED BY THE
LOS ANGELES COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS**

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles has reestablished a \$20,000 reward offered for the purpose of allowing the individuals who provided the information that led to the apprehension of the suspects to file a claim for the reward related to the heinous murder of 61-year-old John Ruh, who was fatally shot while working in a convenience store on the 44400 block of Division Street in Lancaster on February 19, 2018, at approximately 8:30 a.m. **Si no entiende esta noticia o si necesita más informacion, favor de llamar a este numero (213) 974-1579.**

Any person having any information related to this crime is requested to call Detectives Lawler or Blagg at the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department, Homicide Bureau at (323) 890-5500 and refer to Report No. 018-03363-1132-011.

The terms of the reward provide that:

- The information given that leads to the determination of the identity, the apprehension and conviction of any person or persons must be given no later than August 20, 2018. All reward claims must be in writing and shall be received no later than October 19, 2018.
- The total County payment of any and all rewards shall in no event exceed \$20,000 and no claim shall be paid prior to conviction unless the Board of Supervisors makes a finding of impossibility of conviction due to the death or incapacity of the person or persons responsible for the crime or crimes.
- The County reward may be apportioned between various persons and/or paid for the conviction of various persons as the circumstances fairly dictate.
