**59-A. Star View Behavioral Health, Inc. Facility Lease**

**59-B. “Hero Pay” for Frontline-Grocery and Drug Retail Employees in Los Angeles County**

Recommendation as submitted by Supervisors Solis and Mitchell: Instruct the Acting County Counsel, in consultation and collaboration with other relevant Departments, to report back to the Board in writing prior to the January 26, 2021 Board meeting with a proposed Urgency Ordinance that, among other things, requires that stores located in the unincorporated areas of the County that are covered by Appendix B-1 of the County of Los Angeles Department of Public Health Targeted Temporary Safer at Home Health Officer Order and are publicly traded or have at least 300 employees nationwide and more than 10 employees per store site, pay all of their workers an additional \$5 per hour in wages, sunsets 120 days from the effective date of the ordinance and includes any other provisions necessary to implement the intent of this motion; and advises the Board as to whether such an Urgency Ordinance can apply to incorporated and unincorporated areas of the County.
