he terms of office of the Retired Member and Alternate Retired Member of the Board of Retirement and the Retired Member of the Board of Investments will expire on December 31, 2017. To fill these positions, elections will be held this summer.

LACERA retirees interested in becoming a candidate may obtain a nomination packet from the Registrar–Recorder/County Clerk (RRCC), 12400 Imperial Highway, Norwalk, CA 90650, beginning April 24, 2017. To be a candidate, you must get the signatures of 25 LACERA members who retired on or before March 1, 2017. The RRCC must receive signed nominating petitions by 5:00 p.m. on May 23, 2017.

Official ballots will be mailed beginning on June 26, 2017. Those who do not receive a ballot by July 7, 2017, or who wish to correct a mistake on their original ballot, may request a duplicate by notifying the RRCC in writing on or before July 14, 2017, via fax at (562) 466-6025, or via email to fguijaro@rrcc.lacounty.gov or malfonso@rrcc.lacounty.gov.
