45-B. Reward Reestablishment in the Suspicious Disappearance of Jose Lara, Cuauhtemoc Lara and Julieta Arvizu

Recommendation as submitted by Supervisor Barger: Reestablish the \$20,000 reward offered for the purpose of allowing the individual who provided information that led to the whereabouts of the suspect to file a claim for the reward related to the heinous murder of victims Jose Lara, Cuauhtémoc Lara and Julieta Arvizu, who disappeared in January 2018, with their vehicle having been found abandoned in the unincorporated area of Littlerock on February 5, 2018; and make a finding of impossibility of a conviction due to the death of the suspect. 45-C. Supporting the San Gabriel Mountains Foothills and Rivers Protection Act

Recommendation as submitted by Supervisor Solis: Direct the Chief Executive Officer to prepare a five-signature letter to the Los Angeles County Congressional Delegation expressing the County's support for the San Gabriel Mountains Foothills and Rivers Protection Act (Harris), legislation which would expand the boundaries of the San Gabriel Mountains National Monument to include the western areas of the Angeles National Forest, establish a new National Recreation Area to allow resources to flow into the region and increase recreational opportunities for the surrounding communities, and designate portions of the San Gabriel Mountains area as components of the National Wilderness Preservation System and the Wild and Scenic Rivers System.
