

Introduction to Postgovernment Ordinance

The Postgovernment Ordinance prohibits the negotiation of any agreement for future employment or promise of income between specified County officials and those persons or entities with County matters pending before that official or any body of which the official is a member. The Ordinance also permanently prohibits certain paid lobbying in activities of former County Officials concerning specific matters in which the former official was personally and substantively involved. In addition, the Ordinance prohibits certain paid lobbying activities by a former elected County official or Chief Administrative Officer on any matter pending before any County agency, or by a former non-elected County official on any matter pending before his/her former agency, for a period of one year after separation from County service.
