NUMBER OF MEMBERS

Twenty, ten nominated by the Supervisor of the Fourth Supervisorial District, seven nominated by the Supervisor of the Third Supervisorial District and one nominated by the Supervisor of the First, Second and Fifth Supervisorial Districts.

QUALIFICATIONS

Membership shall be comprised of experts, laypersons and spokespersons for those groups and individuals who have an interest in beach-related issues

APPOINTMENT

By Board of Supervisors

TERM OF OFFICE

Four years at the pleasure of the Board of Supervisors.

No member of the Commission may serve more than two consecutive full terms. The Board may, by order, and as it deems appropriate, extend the length of service or waive the limit for individual members, or for the Commission as a whole.

Nomination of a candidate for appointment to the next vacant position for a full term on the Commission, or for the remainder of an unexpired term, shall be made by the Supervisor of the Supervisorial District whose nominee was last appointed to such position.

A member's position on the Commission shall become vacant upon his or her death, resignation, or removal by the Board of Supervisors.

COMPENSATION

None, however, when the members are required to travel in the performance of their duties, they shall be reimbursed for their necessary traveling expenses, including transportation, meals and lodging in accordance with the applicable provisions of chapter 5.40 of the County Code.

MEETINGS

The Commission shall meet on the fourth Wednesday of each month. The Beach Commission meets at 9:30 a.m. and the Facilities Design Subcommittee meets at 9:00 a.m. Meetings will be held at Burton Chace Park Community Building, 13650 Mindanao Way, Marina del Rey.

DUTIES

Consider and from time to time make recommendations to the director and to the Board upon beach-related issues.

OATH

Not required.
