

## **SOLID WASTE FACILITIES HEARING BOARD**

### **AUTHORITY**

Board Order No. 55 of April 14, 1992, Ordinance No. 92-0033. (Also see Section 44800 et seq. of the Public Resources Code and Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations.)

### **NUMBER OF MEMBERS**

Three members, nominated by the Board of Supervisors.

### **QUALIFICATIONS**

Members of the Board shall be selected for their legal, administrative or technical abilities in areas relating to solid waste management.

At least one member of the board shall be a technical expert with knowledge of solid waste management methods and technology.

At least one member shall be a representative of the public at large.

### **APPOINTMENT**

By Board of Supervisors.

### **TERM OF OFFICE**

Two years, at the pleasure of the Board.

No member of the Commission may serve more than two consecutive two-year terms. The Board may, by order, extend the length of service or waive the limit for individuals or the Commission as a whole.

A member's position on the Commission shall become vacant upon his or her death, resignation or removal by the Board. In the case of such a vacancy, the Board shall appoint a successor to fill the unexpired term.

## **COMPENSATION**

\$75.00 per meeting, not to exceed 36 meetings in any one fiscal year.

## **MEETINGS**

At least one regular meeting annually.

## **DUTIES**

Hear and determine appeals, by solid waste facilities permittee or applicants for a solid waste facilities permit, against the rulings, decisions and determinations of the Local Enforcement Agency on permit conditions or the denial, suspension or revocation of permits and other matters as provided for in Public Resources Code Section 44800 et seq. And applicable provisions of title 14 of the California Code of Regulations.

## **OATH**

Not required.
