AUTHORITY

Section 33213 et al. of the Public Resources Code.

NUMBER OF MEMBERS*

Twenty-six members appointed by the following:

A. Fifteen representatives of local governments from jurisdictions including the Santa Monica Mountains as follows:

1. One by the Mayor of the City of Los Angeles
2. One by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles
3. One by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles to represent the unincorporated communities within the jurisdiction of the East Rim of the Valley Trail Corridor, after consultation with the Town Council of Altadena and the Crescenta Valley Town Council
4. One by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Ventura.
5. One by the Thousand Oaks City Council
6. One by the Agoura Hills City Council
7. One by the Burbank City Council
8. One by the Calabasas City Council
9. One by the Glendale City Council
10. One by the La Canada-Flintridge City Council
11. One by the Malibu City Council
12. One by the Pasadena City Council
13. One by the Sierra Madre City Council
14. One by the South Pasadena City Council
15. One by the Westlake Village City Council

- B. Six public members appointed by the following:
 - 1. Two by the Governor
 - 2. Two by the Senate Committee on Rules
 - 3. Two by the Speaker of the Assembly
- C. One by the Rancho Simi Recreation and Park District, to be appointed by the District Board of Directors
- D. One by the Conejo Recreation and Park District, to be appointed by the District Board of Directors
- E. One by the Pleasant Valley Recreation and Park District, to be appointed by the District Board of Directors
- F. One by the Santa Clarita City Council
- G. One by the Moorpark City Council

APPOINTMENT

As indicated above.

TERM OF OFFICE

Indefinite.

COMPENSATION

None, but shall be reimbursed for necessary expenses incurred in the performance of duties.

MEETINGS

Joint meeting with the Santa Monica Conservancy Board, generally on the fourth Thursday of every month at various locations.

DUTIES

Propose and review projects for Conservancy action and report to the Conservancy regarding the conformity of the projects with the plan; review proposed amendments to the plan; and provide opportunities for public participation.

OATH

Required, filed with the Secretary of State.
