

LOS ANGELES EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT COUNCIL

AUTHORITY

Chapter 2.68 of the Los Angeles County Code and Board Order No. 64 of August 1, 1989.

NUMBER OF MEMBERS*

Membership shall be as follows:

- a. Chief Executive Officer, who shall be Chairman.
- b. Sheriff, who shall be Vice-Chairman
- c. Forester and Fire Warden
- d. Director of Public Works
- e. Director of Health Services
- f. Director of Internal Services
- g. Director of Public Social Services
- h. County Counsel, who shall be an ex officio member and without vote
- i. Chief Medical Examiner-Coroner, who shall be an ex officio member and without vote
- j. The County Superintendent of Schools, who shall be an ex officio member and without vote
- k. One member to be nominated by the Los Angeles Chapter of the American Red Cross and appointed by the Board of Supervisors, who shall be an ex officio member and without vote
- l. Such other ex officio non-voting members appointed by the Chairman (Chief Executive Officer), as appropriate

APPOINTMENT

By the Board of Supervisors.

TERM OF OFFICE

Indefinite.

COMPENSATION

None.

MEETINGS*

The Emergency Management Council shall meet upon call of the Chairman (Chief Executive Officer), or in his absence or inability to call such meeting, upon call of the Vice-Chairman, at least three times each calendar year, one of which must be during an emergency exercise.

DUTIES

It shall be the duty of the County Emergency Management Council to oversee the preparedness activities of the various County departments, ensuring unity of purpose, which includes preparation of plans, training of County employees for emergency and disaster related functions, and related emergency preparedness activities.

When requested, the Council shall assist the Board of Supervisors when the County Emergency Organization is mobilized. The Council may appoint committees as it deems necessary to carry out its responsibilities.

OATH

Not required.

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
