**AUTHORITY\***

Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), executed December 23, 2008 and Adopted by the SCL-TAC July 1, 2009.

**SUNSET REVIEW DATE**

January 22, 1998.

**NUMBER OF MEMBERS\***

9 members, the "Appointing Authority" shall appoint eight members of the SCL-CAC. The City's Appointing Authority shall make four appointments and the County's Appointing Authority shall make four appointments. The ninth appointee shall be an employee of one of the following schools: Van Gogh Elementary, Robert Frost Middle School or El Oro Way Elementary, and is appointed by the Board Member of the Los Angeles Unified School District Board of Education in whose district the three schools are located. A majority of the Members shall reside within a six mile radius of the Sunshine Canyon Landfill.

**APPOINTMENT**

By Board of Supervisors.

**TERM OF OFFICE**

Two years.

**COMPENSATION**

None.

## **MEETINGS\***

The meetings are to be held twice monthly at a location to be determined, the location shall be conducive to a public meeting, ADA compliant, and is able to seat at least 30 people.

## **DUTIES**

To serve as liaison between the permittee and the community and as means for the community to communicate with the Regional Planning Commission and other regulatory agencies on an ongoing basis regarding issues involved in the development and operation of the Landfill.

Upon appointment of the Committee by the Board of Supervisors, the permittee shall do the following:

- a. Provide qualified personnel to regularly attend Committee meetings;
- b. Provide reasonable access to the landfill site and information concerning landfill operations necessary for the Committee to perform the Committee's functions;
- c. Provide accommodations for Committee meetings; and
- d. Provide funding, not to exceed \$20,000 dollars per annum, for the committee to retain independent consultants, provided that any consultant retained shall be a person who by education, training and experience is qualified to undertake the work for which the consultant is retained and who has no conflict of interest with the permittee or any member of the Committee.

## **OATH**

Not required.
