

## LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION

### AUTHORITY

Section 56000 et seq. of the Government Code and AB1335 (Gotch).

### NUMBER OF MEMBERS\*

Nine regular members and six alternate members as follows:

- a. Two County members nominated by the Chair, Board of Supervisors
- b. Two city members appointed by a City Selection Committee composed of mayors of all cities within Los Angeles County
- c. One member from the Los Angeles City Council appointed by the presiding officer of the City Council
- d. One public member who must be a resident of the San Fernando Valley Statistical Area appointed by the Board of Supervisors
- e. Two special district members appointed by an Independent Special District Selection Committee, composed of one member from each of the independent special districts within Los Angeles County
- f. One public member selected by the other eight members
- g. Seven alternate members representing each of the above categories

## **APPOINTMENT**

County members of the Commission are selected and appointed by the Board of Supervisors from its own membership.

## **TERM OF OFFICE**

Four years or until the appointment and qualification of their successors. Any member ceasing to be a city, county or special district officer during his term shall have his membership on the Commission vacated.

## **COMPENSATION**

\$150 per meeting for all members and alternates.

## **MEETINGS**

Second and Fourth Wednesday of each month, at 9:00 a.m., in Room 381B, Kenneth Hahn Hall of Administration, 500 West Temple Street, Los Angeles, 90012.

## **DUTIES**

The Commission shall have the following powers and duties, subject to the limitations upon its jurisdiction herein set forth:

- a. To review and approve or disapprove with or without amendment, wholly, partially, or conditionally proposals for the incorporation of cities; the annexation and/or detachment of territory to or from local agencies; the disincorporation or dissolution of a local agency; the consolidation or merger of two or more cities or districts.
- b. To adopt policies and procedures for the evaluation of proposals; to make and enforce rules and regulations for the orderly and fair conduct of hearings by the Commission.

Required.
