

## **AVIATION COMMISSION**

### **AUTHORITY** \*

Chapter 3.08 of the Los Angeles County Code; Board Order No. 9 of March 7, 1995; Board Order No. 20 of August 10, 1999, and Board Order No. 50 of August 17, 1999, Ordinance # 99-0076 (extension of sunset review date); Board Order No. 23 of September 7, 2004 (extension of sunset review date); and Board Order No. 8 of September 21, 2010; Board Order No. 31 of October 14, 2014, Ordinance No. 2014-0042 (extension of sunset review date).

### **SUNSET REVIEW DATE**\*

June 1, 2019.

### **NUMBER OF MEMBERS**

Ten, two nominated by each Supervisor.

### **APPOINTMENT**

By Board of Supervisors.

### **TERM OF OFFICE**

Four years, at the pleasure of the Board.

No member of the Commission may serve more than two consecutive four year terms. The Board may, by order, extend this length of service or waive this limit for individuals or the Commission as a whole.

A member's position on the Commission shall become vacant upon his or her death, resignation, or removal by the Board. In the case of such a vacancy, the Board shall appoint a successor to fill the unexpired term.

### **COMPENSATION**\*

Commissioners will be paid \$25 for each official meeting attended, not to exceed 24 meetings per fiscal year.

## **MEETINGS\***

Meetings are to be held on the last Wednesday of each month at 9:00 a.m., at various locations within the County of Los Angeles and designated by the contact person.

The provisions of Chapter 5.12 of the County code shall not apply to the Commission.

## **DUTIES**

Consider and recommend to:

1. County Planning Commission
  - a. Master plan for airports and heliports in Los Angeles County.
  - b. Regulations and specifications for issuance of permits for establishment and expansion of airports and heliports, and regulations and plans for zoning approaches to airports and heliports and limiting type of buildings and natural growth of areas adjacent to airports and heliports.
  - c. Acquisition of sites for County airports and heliports.
2. Board of Supervisors
  - a. Acquisition of sites for County airports and heliports.
  - b. Establishment of regulations for management and operation of such airports and heliports.
  - c. All other matters affecting or concerning airports, heliports and aircraft.
3. Director of Public Works
  - a. Regulations and plans for development of aviation in Los Angeles County, including proposals for enlargement of facilities to serve the aviation industry.
  - b. Programs for promotion and growth of aviation.
