

FISH AND WILDLIFE COMMISSION

NUMBER OF MEMBERS

Five, one nominated by each Supervisor.

QUALIFICATIONS

Each of whom shall reside in Los Angeles County.

APPOINTMENT

By Board of Supervisors

TERM OF OFFICE

Two years at the pleasure of the Board.

No member of the Commission may serve more than two consecutive two year terms. The Board may, by order, extend the length of service or waive the limit for individuals or the Commission as a whole.

A members position on the Commission shall become vacant upon his or her death, resignation, or removal by the Board of Supervisors. In the case of such a vacancy, the Board of Supervisors shall appoint a successor to fill the unexpired term.

COMPENSATION

\$25 per meeting attended, not to exceed \$50 in any one month.

MEETINGS*

Second Thursday of January, April, July (if needed) and October in Room 374 of the Kenneth Hahn Hall of Administration, 500 West Temple Street, Los Angeles, 90012. (Meetings shall be held at least four times a year).

The provisions of Chapter 5.12 of the County Code shall not apply to the Commission.

DUTIES

The members of the Fish and Wildlife Commission shall devote their time and thought to the best methods for the propagation and protection of fish and game in the State of California and Los Angeles County. The Commission shall be an advisory body, and make such recommendations to the Board of Supervisors at least two times a year, and to the Fish and Wildlife Warden, as it may deem to be reasonable, necessary or advisable.

OATH

Not required.
