AUTHORITY

Board Order No. 30 of July 24, 2001.

NUMBER OF MEMBERS

Five.

APPOINTMENT

Appointments shall be as follows:

- a. The Los Angeles County Sheriff shall be a member of the Authority and shall appoint one other person to serve as a member of the Authority.
- b. The Chief of Police for the City of Los Angeles shall be a member of the Authority and shall appoint one other person to serve as a member of the Authority.
- c. The President of CSULA shall appoint one person to serve as a member of the Authority.

TERM OF OFFICE

Three years.

The terms of the three members who are appointees shall begin on appointment and shall be for three years, provided however that the appointees shall serve at the pleasure of their respective appointing officials.

The Chairperson of the Authority shall serve for one year and the members of the Authority shall rotate as Chairperson on an annual basis, in a manner to be determined by the Authority. The first Chairperson shall be the Los Angeles County Sheriff.

COMPENSATION

None.

MEETINGS

Meetings may be called by the Chairperson or any two (2) Directors. The Authority shall provide for at least one regular meeting to be held each year. Special meetings of the Authority may be called in accordance with the provisions of Section 54956 of the California Government Code or any successor provision thereto.

DUTIES*

To oversee the design, construction and operation activities supporting the Regional Forensic Crime Laboratory which will accommodate the forensic needs of the Sheriff's Department and the Los Angeles City Police Department in addition to the forensic training objectives of California State University, Los Angeles (CSULA) in a shared facility; request the Sheriff to notify the City of Los Angeles, CSULA and the State Office of Criminal Justice Planning of the Authority's action.

OATH

Not required.
