

## **COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICTS**

### **AUTHORITY**

Section 61000 et seq. of the Government Code.

### **APPOINTMENT**

Elected. Each District shall have a Board of three or five Directors as stated in the petition for formation.

### **TERM OF OFFICE**

Four years.

### **QUALIFICATIONS**

Shall be a registered elector residing within the boundaries of the District.

### **DUTIES**

A District formed under this law may exercise the powers granted for any of the following purposes designated in the petition for formation of a District and for such other of the following purposes that the District shall adopt:

- a. To supply the inhabitants of the District with water for domestic use, irrigation, sanitation, industrial use, fire protection, and recreation
- b. The collection, treatment or disposal of sewage, waste and storm water of the District and its inhabitants
- c. The collection or disposal of garbage or refuse matter.
- d. Protection against fire
- e. Public recreation by means of parks, including but not limited to aquatic parks and recreational harbors, playgrounds, golf courses, swimming pools or recreation buildings
- f. Street lighting

- g. Mosquito abatement.
- h. The equipment and maintenance of a police department, other police protection to protect and safeguard life and property.
- i. To acquire sites for, construct, and maintain library buildings, and to cooperate with other governmental agencies for library service.
- j. The constructing, opening, widening, extending, straightening, and surfacing, in whole or in part, of any street in such district, subject to the consent of the governing body of the county or city in which said improvement is to be made.
- k. The construction and improvement of bridges, culverts, curbs, gutters, drains, and works incidental to the purposes specified in sub-division (j), subject to the consent of the governing body of the county or city in which said improvement is to be made.
- l. To contract for ambulance service to serve the residents of the District as convenience requires, if a majority of the voters in the District, voting in an election thereon, approve.
- m. To provide and maintain public airports and landing places for aerial traffic.
