

ACCESS SERVICES INCORPORATED

AUTHORITY

Government Code 15975 et seq., Internal Revenue Code 501 et seq. and Board Order No. 55 of April 8, 1997.

NUMBER OF MEMBERS

Seven members, appointed as follows:

- a. One director shall be appointed by the County of Los Angeles Board of Supervisors.
- b. One director shall be appointed by City Selection Committee's Corridor Transportation. Representatives representing the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (LACMTA).
- c. One director shall be appointed by the Mayor of the City of Los Angeles.
- d. One director shall be elected by the governing boards of the municipal fixed route operators and shall be a governing board member or staff person of any municipal operator that is a member of the corporation.
- e. One director shall be elected by the governing boards of the local fixed route operators and shall be a governing board member or staff person of any local operator that is a member of the corporation.
- f. One director shall be appointed by the Los Angeles County Commission on Disabilities through an open public process.
- g. One director shall be appointed by the Los Angeles County Independent Living Centers through an open public process.

- h. One director shall be appointed by the Board of Directors of the LACMTA and shall be a governing board member or staff person of that organization familiar with transit finance or operations.
- i. One director shall be appointed first by the local fixed route operators and then by the municipal fixed route operators and such appointment shall thereafter successively alternate between them.

ALTERNATE MEMBERS

None.

APPOINTMENT

As indicated above.

TERM OF OFFICE

All directors will serve two year terms beginning July 1st and ending June 30th. Directors will serve alternate terms with the terms of the County of Los Angeles, City Selection Committee's Corridor Transportation Representative, City of Los Angeles and the Los Angeles County Commission on Disabilities.

LACMTA, Municipal Operators, Local Operators, Los Angeles County Independent Living Center, Alternating seat between Local and Municipal Operators directors beginning and ending in even-numbered years and the terms of the municipal and local directors beginning and ending in odd-numbered years.

Directors shall only be removed by a majority of the representatives of the appropriate membership class.

COMPENSATION

In an amount not to exceed \$100.00 per meeting. Compensation will be optional and would only be paid upon written submission for payment from a Board Member.

DUTIES

Access Services Incorporated (ASI) is a private non-profit corporation which is the Consolidated Transportation Services Agency (CTSA) for Los Angeles County. As the CTSA, ASI has the responsibility to:

- a. Improve and coordinate the paratransit services of Los Angeles County social service, private and public paratransit operators.
- b. Develop a countywide, cost effective coordinated network of complementary paratransit services for persons with severe disabilities as required by the Americans with Disabilities Act
