NUMBER OF MEMBERS

Seven, consisting of the following:

- a. The Chairman of the Board of Supervisors or a member of the Board of Supervisors designated by the Chairman
- b. Sheriff
- c. District Attorney
- d. Chief of Police of a department having the largest number of sworn personnel in Los Angeles County
- e. A second Chief of Police selected from other Chiefs within Los Angeles County
- f. Mayor of the City with the greatest population within Los Angeles County
- g. A member at large chosen by the members of the CAL-ID Board

TERM OF OFFICE

The Chairman, Board of Supervisors position term expires annually when the new Chairman takes office and all other commissioners serve an indefinite term.
