QUALIFICATIONS

All of whom shall be residents of Los Angeles County.

In addition to the members selected, as stated above, the following County department heads or staff members shall be ex officio members:

- a. President of the Department of Museum of Natural History
- b. County Librarian
- c. Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk
- d. County Administrator/Clerk, Los Angeles Municipal Court
- e. Executive Officer/Clerk, Superior Court

APPOINTMENT

By Board of Supervisors.

TERM OF OFFICE

Four years, until his successor is appointed, at the pleasure of the Board.

No member of the Los Angeles Historical Landmarks and Records Commission may serve more than two consecutive four year terms. The Board may, by order, extend the length of service or waive the limit for individuals or the Commission as a whole.

A member's position on the Commission shall become vacant upon his or her death, resignation, or removal by the Board. In the case of such a vacancy, the Board shall appoint a successor to fill the unexpired term.

OFFICERS

The Commission shall elect a chair and vice-chair, from the members thereof, each of whom will serve for one year, and thereafter until a successor is elected.

MEETINGS

Meet quarterly on a date and at a time determined by the Chairperson in the Office of Kenneth Hahn Hall of Administration, 500 West Temple Street, Los Angeles, 90012.

DUTIES

The Commission shall consider and recommend to the Board local historical landmarks defined to be worthy of registration by the State of California Department of Parks and Recreation, either as "California Historical Landmarks" or as "Points of Historical Interest", and may consider and comment for the Board on applications relating to the National Register of Historic Places.

Criteria for designation, including significance and access and provision for maintenance, shall be as specified in state law, including the California Public Resources Code, or in regulations and interpretations of the State Historical Resources Commission.

OATH

Not required.
