AUTHORITY*

Chapter 2.82 of the Los Angeles County Code, Board Order No. 76 of November 30, 1982, Board Order No. 32 of October 26, 1993, Ordinance No. 93-0073, Board Order No. 11 of January 3, 1995, Board Order No. 10 of November 5, 1996. Board Order No. 9 of February 27, 2001 and Board Order No. 66 of March 6, 2001, Ordinance No. 2001-0024 (extension of sunset review date). Board Order No. 23 and Board Order No. 60 of May 8, 2007 and Board Order No. 58 of May 15, 2007, Ordinance No. 2007-0056 (extension of sunset review date).

SUNSET REVIEW DATE*

October 1, 2011.

NUMBER OF MEMBERS

Ten, consisting of two from each Supervisorial District and the Sheriff and the Chief Probation Officer shall serve as ex officio member.

APPOINTMENT

By Board of Supervisors.

TERM OF OFFICE

Four years at the pleasure of the Board.

No member of the Commission may serve more than two consecutive four year terms. The Board may, by order, extend this length of service or waive this limit for individuals or the Commission as a whole.

A member's position on the Commission shall become vacant upon his or her death, resignation, or removal by the Board. In the case of such a vacancy, the Board shall appoint a successor to fill the unexpired term.

COMPENSATION

\$50 for each meeting attended, not to exceed three meetings per week, but in no event to exceed 156 meetings per year.

MEETINGS

Each Wednesday, at 10:00 a.m., in Room 372, Kenneth Hahn Hall of Administration, 500 West Temple Street, Los Angeles, 90012.

Provisions of Chapter 5.12 of the County Code shall not apply to the Commission.

DUTIES

At least once each year and as more often as the Commission may deem necessary or proper or as directed by a judge of the Superior Court, the members of the Commission or of a committee of the commission shall visit and inspect each jail or lockup in Los Angeles County, County probation and correctional facilities and toy-loan facilities. The members of the Commission, in visiting and inspecting jails and lockups as provided in this chapter, shall examine every department of each institution visited and shall ascertain its condition as to effective and economical administration, the cleanliness, discipline and comfort of its inmates, and in any other respects, whether such institution is located within or without the corporate limits of any incorporated city. Every member of the Commission, while visiting and inspecting a jail or lockup as provided in this chapter, may call for and inspect the permit and register of such jail and lockup and may see and visit all persons kept in such jail and lockup. The Commission may also inspect group home facilities.

OATH

Not required.
