Chapter 3.46 of the Los Angeles County Code; Board Order No. 10 of June 25, 1991; Board Order No. 11 of June 23, 1992; Board Order No. 7 of September 28, 1993; Board Order No. 53 of January 23, 1996; Board Order No. 21 of September 1, 2009 (extension of sunset review date); Board Order No. 17 of January 10, 2012 (extension of sunset review date).

NUMBER OF MEMBERS

Five, one nominated by each Supervisor.

APPOINTMENT

By Board of Supervisors.

TERM OF OFFICE

Four years at the pleasure of the Board.

No member of the Commission may serve more than two consecutive four year terms. The Board may, by order, extend this length of service or waive this limit for individuals or the Commission as a whole.

A member's position on the Commission shall become vacant upon his or her death, resignation, or removal by the Board. In the case of such a vacancy, the Board shall appoint a successor to fill the unexpired term.

COMPENSATION*

\$25 per meeting attended, not to exceed two meetings in any one month. On September 28, 1993, the Board requested the Commissioners to voluntarily forgo their stipends. The Parks and Recreation Commissioners have volunteered to forgo their stipends. On July 7, 2008, the Commission voted to amend their by-laws, deleting the voluntary waiver of stipends to be effective beginning with the next meeting.

MEETINGS

Commission meetings are held quarterly beginning every January. The meetings will be scheduled on the first Monday of the quarter, unless it is a holiday or otherwise specified and; the location will be selected at each Commission meeting and noted on the agenda.

The provisions of Chapter 5.12 of the County Code shall not apply to the Commission.

DUTIES

Advise the Board of Supervisors, the Director of Parks and Recreation, and other County officers as to the acquisition, improvements and government of County parks, other recreational areas and facilities, recreation programs, and related recreation matters, excepting beaches. The Commission's duties shall be wholly advisory.

OATH

Not required.
