

## SANTA MONICA MOUNTAINS CONSERVANCY BOARD (STATE)

### AUTHORITY

Section 33000 et al. of the Public Resources Code.

### NUMBER OF MEMBERS\*

Nine voting members and two ex officio members appointed as follows:

- a. The Superintendent of the Santa Monica Mountains National Recreation Area, or his or her designee.
- b. A member representing the City of Los Angeles, appointed by the Mayor with the approval of the City Council.
- c. Three public members who shall be residents of either the County of Los Angeles or the County of Ventura, one of whom shall be appointed by the Governor, one of whom shall be appointed by the Senate Committee on Rules, and one of whom shall be appointed by the Speaker of the Assembly. At least one of the public members shall reside within the San Fernando Valley statistical area defined in Section 11093 of the Government Code.
- d. An elected official who is a representative nominated by the city councils of those cities which have at least 75 percent of their areas within the zone who shall be appointed by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles or a member appointed by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles, or that member's designee.
- e. An elected official who is either a member of the City Council of the City of Thousand Oaks or a member of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Ventura and who shall be appointed by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Ventura, or the elected official's designee.
- f. The Secretary of the Resources Agency or an employee of the agency designated by the secretary.
- g. The Superintendent of the Angeles District of the Department of Parks and Recreation, or his or her designee.

- h. Two ex officio nonvoting members appointed by the California Coastal Commission and the State Coastal Conservancy who shall be either a member or employee of their respective agency.

### **APPOINTMENT**

As indicated above.

### **TERM OF OFFICE**

Indefinite.

### **COMPENSATION\***

The following members of the conservancy shall be compensated for attendance at regular meetings of the conservancy at the rate of one hundred dollars (\$100) per day:

(A) The public members.

(B) The member appointed by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles or that member's designee, unless the member or designee is also a member of the Board of Supervisors, in which case no compensation shall be paid, pursuant to Public Resource Code 33200(d)(1)

### **MEETINGS\***

Meetings are held the fourth Thursday of every month, and joint meeting with Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy Advisory Committee at various locations.

### **DUTIES**

Award grants or make loans to cities, counties, resource conservation districts and recreation and park districts for the purpose of restoring areas which adversely affect the Santa Monica Mountains and to acquire sites identified as necessary for park, recreation, or conservation purpose and for development of essential public facilities.

**OATH**

Required, filed with the Secretary of State.
