APPOINTMENT

By Board of Supervisors.

TERM OF OFFICE

Four years.

No member of the Commission may serve more than two consecutive four-year terms. The Board may, by order, extend this length of service or waive this limit for individuals or the Commission as a whole.

A member's position on the Commission shall become vacant upon his or her death, resignation, or removal by the Board. In the case of such a vacancy, the Board shall appoint a successor to fill the unexpired term.

COMPENSATION

\$20.00 for each general meeting attended, not to exceed two meetings in any one calendar month. \$20.00 for each Executive Committee meeting attended, not to exceed two meetings in any one calendar month.

Members shall be reimbursed for necessary traveling expenses, including transportation, meals and lodging, when they are required to travel in the performance of Commission duties.

MEETINGS

General meetings are held a minimum of twelve times per year. The yearly schedule is published in October and is available from the Los Angeles County Arts Commission office.

The provisions of Chapter 5.12 of the County Code shall not apply to the Commission.

DUTIES

Subject to the supervision of the Board of Supervisors, the Commission shall recommend to the Board the persons, firms or corporations with whom or which the County should, pursuant to Section 25562 of the government Code, contract to provide artistic performances within Los Angeles County, including but not limited to, operas, symphonies, band concerts and other instrumental concerts, historical or commemorative pageants, choral concerts, plays or other related presentations (with or without music), ballet, dance, recitals, exhibitions and readings.

The Commission shall annually elect from the members thereof a President of the commission to serve for one year.

OATH

Not required.
