NUMBER OF MEMBERS

Fifteen.

QUALIFICATIONS

All of whom shall be interested in promoting the activities of the County's Arboreta and Botanic Gardens and be willing to devote their time to this cause.

No more than two officers of the following shall serve on the Board of Governors at any one time:

- a. California Arboretum Foundation
- b. Descanso Gardens Guild
- c. South Coast Botanic Garden Foundation
- d. Southern California Camellia Council
- e. Similar supporting organization

TERM OF OFFICE

Four years at the pleasure of the Board.

A member's position on the Board of Governors shall become vacant upon his or her death, resignation, or removal by the Board of Supervisors. In the case of such a vacancy, the Board of Supervisors shall appoint a successor to fill the unexpired term.

No member of the Board of Governors may serve more than two consecutive four year terms. The Board may, by order, extend the length of service or waive the limit for individuals or the Board of Governors as a whole.

COMPENSATION

Members of the Board of Governors shall serve without compensation except when required to travel in the performance of their duties, they shall be reimbursed for their necessary traveling expenses, including transportation, meals and lodging.

MEETINGS

First Wednesday of every other month in a location designated by the contact person.

The provisions of Chapter 5.12 of the County Code shall not apply to the Board of Governors.

DUTIES

The duties of said Board of Governors is to advise and provide support to the Board of Supervisors and the Director in the general management of the County's Arboreta and Botanic Gardens.
