

REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION

AUTHORITY

Section 65100 et seq. of the Government Code, Chapter 2.108 of the Los Angeles County Code and Ordinance No. 91-0032.

NUMBER OF MEMBERS

Five, one nominated by each Supervisor.

Advisory Members:

- a. Director of Public Works
- b. Agricultural Commissioner/Director of Weights and Measures
- c. Director of Parks and Recreation
- d. Forester and Fire Warden

Each advisory member may designate one of his deputies to sit on the Commission in his absence.

APPOINTMENT

By Board of Supervisors.

TERM OF OFFICE

Four years, at the pleasure of the Board.

No member of the Commission may serve more than two consecutive four year terms. The Board may, by order, extend the length of service or waive the limit for individuals or the Commission as whole.

A member's position on the Commission shall become vacant upon his or her death, resignation, or removal by the Board. In the case of such a vacancy, the Board shall appoint a successor to fill the unexpired term.

COMPENSATION

\$150 per meeting, not to exceed fifteen meetings in any calendar month, and in addition, \$150 per meeting of the Zoning Board attended as a member of the Board.

MEETINGS

Every Wednesday and as needed, at 9:00 a.m., in Room 150, Hall of Records, 320 West Temple Street, Los Angeles, 90012.

Section 5.12.050 of the Los Angeles County Code provides that if any member (other than an ex officio member) fails to attend three consecutive meetings, unless excused by the members thereof, that member's office becomes vacant. The secretary shall so notify the appointing officer, who shall immediately appoint a member to fill such vacancy.

DUTIES

The duties of the Commission shall be as follows:

- a. Prepare, periodically review, and revise, as necessary, the General Plan.
- b. Implement the General Plan through actions including, but not limited to, the administration of specific plans and zoning and subdivision ordinances.
- c. Annually review the capital improvement program of Los Angeles County and the local public works projects of other local agencies for their consistency with the General Plan, pursuant to Article 7 (commencing with Section 65400).
- d. Endeavor to promote public interest in, comment on, and understanding of the General Plan, and regulations relating to it.
- e. Consult and advise with public officials and agencies, public utility companies, civic, educational, professional and other organizations, and citizens generally concerning implementation of the General Plan.

- f. Promote the coordination of local plans and programs with the plans and programs of other public agencies.
- g. Perform other functions as the legislative body provides, including conducting studies and preparing plans other than those required or authorized by this title.
